HURN NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

We had a 3 month delay this summer whilst we awaited a response on certain items from BCP Council. However, the Neighbourhood Plan is now nearing completion for its submission, when a Government Inspector will be appointed to consider the Plan and make comments on it or suggest any changes. Following that, a final Plan will be produced which will be put to a local referendum.

The policies contained in the plan cover:

- 1. Conserving and Enhancing Hurn's Historic Character
- 2. Local Landscape Character
- 3. Important Local Gap
- 4. Access to the Countryside
- 5. Woodland, Heathland and Farmland
- 6. Supporting Community Facilities and Local Services
- 7. Creating safer roads and pedestrian / cycle routes
