Garage is currently used in breach of condition 14 of the Grant of Planning Permission under Application no 8/94/0111F, in that the garage has been used for purposes other than, “for the parking of private vehicles only and no other purpose”. This breach has existed continuously since a date prior to 2005(i.e.) for a period of longer than ten continuous years). Building is currently carpeted, fitted with a ceiling, supplied with electrical power and lighting, and is used for habitable (domestic) purposes. The garage is edged in red on the attached copy of the title deed, shown as a separate rectangular block attached by its corner to the main section of the property also edged in red.
