27/20 CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

28/20 APOLOGIES

None.

29/20 SIGNING OF THE MINUTES

Cllr Mrs H Balkaya Shore proposed that the minutes of the meeting held on 10th February 2020 were a true record, this was seconded by Cllr M Cranham, and it was **resolved** that they be signed by the Chairman.

30/20 CODE OF CONDUCT OF LOCAL AUTHORITY MEMBERS

The Chairman reminded members of the need to declare their interests at all meetings where matters being discussed, or to be discussed, affected their interests.

31/20 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The meeting was closed at 7.36 pm.

a) Proposal to close one-way section of Hurn Court Lane

Cllr Mrs J Jones arrived at 7.39pm.

Two Residents of Hurn Court raised concerns about the proposal to permanently close the one-way section of Hurn Court Lane. They commented that Mill Lane was very potholed and the One way section was shorter and quicker. Cllr Mrs M Phipps said that they needed to report the problem with the potholes. She explained the background to the closure with the Police unable to prevent the significant number of vehicles going the wrong way down the one way section. A meeting had been held on site with interested parties. The road will remain open to pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders.

The proposal will go to the BCP Traffic Advisory Group, Residents are welcome to write and object if they wish to. The Residents thanked her for the background information of which they had been unaware.

The meeting was reopened at 7.51 pm.

32/20 GENERAL PARISH MATTERS.

a) Open Spaces: Town Common/Sopley Common/Ramsdown, Hurn Forest:

Cllr Mrs H Balkaya Shore reported the truck which appeared to be permanently parked in the layby by Hurn Bridge Sports Club. It has now been moved.

Cllr Mrs J Jones reported that there had been a nasty accident on Sopley Common. A horse rider was injured after she fell when her horse was chased by out of control dogs.

b) Gravel Extraction: Avon Common– Hurn Court – Potential New Sites

Cllr H Greenman reported that he was hopeful the issue of a diesel generator running 24 hours a day, for the duration of the proposed extension to the Hurn Court quarry could be resolved. **Leave on Agenda for May meeting.**

c) Roads

Cllr Mrs M Phipps updated Councillors. The work at Blackwater is continuing. The problems travelling north into Hurn exiting at Blackwater have worsened. The work is due to finish by the end of May. There have been roadworks affecting Hurn since 2017.

Cllr Mrs M Phipps has reported the problems with the culvert under Matchams Lane. Cllr Mrs H Balkaya Shore has reported problems with flooding on sections of the pavement along Parley Lane from opposite Hurn Court Lane to the Village. **Leave on Agenda for May meeting.**

d) A338 Bridleway 7 Diversion

f) Neighbourhood Plan

The Residents survey and Newsletter were distributed to Residents. Cllr Mrs M Phipps has entered the responses received into the Survey Analysis System. Jo Witherden will analyse the results when all the responses have been received. The Steering Group will decide whether to send out a reminder at their meeting on 16th March. Mrs M Phipps has forwarded the Housing Needs Assessment to Councillors.

Jo Witherden has agreed to make a presentation about the Neighbourhood Plan at the Annual Assembly. Cllr Mrs M Phipps explained that Councillors would need to decide closer to the time, whether it should go ahead depending on the advice concerning the Coronavirus. **Leave on Agenda for May meeting.**

g) Local Plan for Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole

h) Bus shelter

A car hit the bus shelter and bridge causing considerable damage. The driver apologised and has provided his insurance details. BCP Council have cleared away the debris including the bus shelter. There is now a sheer drop at the rear of the bus stop. Cllr Mrs M Phipps will coordinate with BCP Council to make an insurance claim.

The Clerk has been invited to a meeting of BCP Town and Parish Councils. She was asked to raise the issue of the ongoing road works particularly how long the work at Blackwater was taking.

Cllr I Evans reported he had filled in the Flood Warden report and submitted it. The next Single Point of Contact meeting be hosted by Hurn Parish Council on 13th May.

Cllr Mrs J Jones reported that the Airport Consultative Committee meeting was not held due to the Coronavirus. She summarised the slides which had been distributed instead.
