52/20 CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the Skype Council meeting.

54/20 SIGNING OF THE MINUTES

Cllr M Cranham proposed that the minutes of the meeting held on 8th June 2020 were a true record, this was seconded by Cllr Mrs H Balkaya Shore, and it was **resolved** that they be signed by the Chairman.

57/20 GENERAL PARISH MATTERS.

a) Open Spaces: Town Common/Sopley Common/Ramsdown, Hurn Forest:

Cllr Mrs M Phipps reported that cycle circuit with jumps in Ramsdown Forest had been flattened by the Forestry Commission. They had also filled in the holes.

Cllr H Greenman has mowed the grass on the Village Green and tidied the area. A Resident has volunteered to help him with the mowing. Cllr H Greenman has his contact details. **Leave on Agenda for August meeting.**

b) Gravel Extraction:

Cllr Mrs M Phipps had arranged a visit on site, for the proposed extension to Hurn Court quarry, with Officers from BCP Council and Dorset Council, but it was postponed due to the current Covid 19 situation. She has called the application in. She agreed to follow up the current status. **Leave on Agenda for August meeting.**

c) Roads

Cllr I Evans reported that trees were being felled on the Avon Causeway to improve the site lines. They have currently stopped felling. Cllr Mrs M Phipps explained a tree

officer had visited. The trees were not covered by a Tree Protection Order (TPO) and were not in a Conservation area. The Officer can ask for a TPO to be applied but the trees may be felled before it is in place. Cllr Mrs M Phipps will follow it up. Cllr I Evans agreed to speak to the owner of Toll Cottage. **Leave on Agenda for August meeting.**

d) A338 Bridleway 7 Diversion

Cllr Mrs M Phipps reported that the horse lights have not been installed yet on the Avon Causeway, she will follow it up.

e) Playground

The playground reopened on the 4th July. A revised risk assessment was completed. Cllr M Cranham carried out a detailed inspection and put up information signs. He reported that a few children had been using it sensibly. The signs had been provided free of charge by BCP Council. Cllr Mrs M Phipps had thanked Michael Rowland at BCP Council who had been very helpful.

58/20 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Meeting was closed at 7.54 pm.

A Colmer comment that since the entrance to Bridleway 7, opposite Brickfield Lane had been widened there had been fly tipping. She will report it to BCP Council. The meeting was reopened at 7.57pm.

59/20 CORRESPONDENCE

A list of correspondence had been circulated prior to the meeting.

Cllr I Evans had received an email from Burton and Winkton Parish Council. There had been a spate of thefts and break ins in Winkton. Burton Residents have also had vehicles broken into on a regular basis. Apparently when these were reported to the Police, they were given a crime reference number so they could claim on their insurance. No other action was taken by the Police and they were advised to look to their own security. Councillors considered these crimes to be a cause for concern. It was agreed the Clerk would email PC G Stokes to ask what the response would be from the Police if similar incidents occurred in Hurn.
