76/20 CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the Skype Council meeting.

77/20 APOLOGIES

81/20 GENERAL PARISH MATTERS.

a) Open Spaces: Town Common/Sopley Common/Ramsdown, Hurn Forest:

Cllr M Cranham queried what was happening about the temporary fence where the bus shelter had been. Cllr Mrs M Phipps agreed to follow this up. **Leave on Agenda for October meeting.**

b) Gravel Extraction

Cllr Mrs M Phipps attended and spoke at the BCP Council, Planning Committee meeting deciding applications 8/20/0016/CONDR and 8/20/0017/CONDR. The Committee agreed that a condition be imposed that an electric generator should be used not a diesel one. It was also agreed that the position of the water discharge point would be reviewed to the satisfaction of the Council. **Leave on Agenda for October meeting.**

c) Roads

Cllr Mrs M Phipps emailed BCP Council asking for drainage the pipe under Matchams Lane to be cleared.

Cllrs reported concerns about the industrial units on the Bosley Nursery site. Commercial vehicles from the Telecoms company are parking in the layby outside Hurn Bridge Sports Club. A unit at the end of the of the site appears to be burning waste and then burying the ash. The smoke is causing a nuisance to residents in Moors Close. Cllrs were also concerned about contamination as the site is next to the SSI. It was agreed that the Malmesbury estate would be notified as Landlord and asked to rectify the issues. **Leave on Agenda for October meeting.**

d) A338 Bridleway 7 Diversion
