8/22/0075/TTPO Technology Centre 9 Enterprise Way - Aviation Park West G2 – mixed species group - structural prune to enhance natural shape and form. Subordinate rapidly growing lateral branches. T1 – PINE – Raise branches by maximum of 1m to give a clearance to parking spaces of 2.5m T3 – BIRCH – cut back by maximum of 1.5m to clear road T4 – PINE - Raise branches by maximum of 1m to give a clearance to parking spaces of 2.5m T6 – PINE- cut back by maximum of 1.5m to clear road

8/21/1181/TTPO at 17 & 19 Matchams Lane T1g - Scots Pine - Remove Deadwood.
T2 & T3 - English Oak - Raise canopy over driveway by 5m. T4 - English Oak - Fell to ground level. T5 - Silver Birch - Raise canopy to 5m above ground level. Thin canopy by 20%.
T6 - Sweet Chestnut - Reduce lateral canopy over applicant's property by approx. 2m.
T7g - Leyland Cypress - Reduce northern lateral growth by approx. 2m and reduce canopy to give 2m clearance from property. T8g - 5 x Scots Pine, 4 x Birch, 2 x Goat Willow - Fell to ground level.
