### 100/24 SIGNING OF THE MINUTES

### 103/24 GENERAL PARISH MATTERS.

#### a) Open Spaces: Town Common/Sopley Common/Ramsdown, Hurn Forest:

Cllr M Cranham reported that there were advertising signs for the Sawmill on several verges. It was agreed the Clerk would contact the business asking if the signs were permanent. If they were, they would need planning permission. **Leave on Agenda for September meeting.**

**c) Neighbourhood Plan**

Cllr Mrs M Phipps updated Cllrs. The Inspector has reported that subject to specified modification the Hurn Neighbourhood plan meets the Basic Conditions and recommends it should proceed to referendum. The modifications to the plan were discussed.

Cllr M Cranham proposed the Hurn Neighbourhood Plan be taken forward to referendum, this was seconded by Cllrs Mrs H Balkaya Shore and passed unanimously. The plan will be reviewed in 2027/28.

BCP Council have 5 weeks to make a decision to take the plan forward to a referendum. Cllr Mrs M Phipps has notified BCP Council that the Parish Council expect the Referendum to go ahead in October which they have noted. A newsletter will need to be distributed prior to the referendum. **Leave on Agenda September meeting.**

**Proposal:** Expansion of existing fuel farm, including above  
ground fuel storage tanks, interceptor, vehicle access and  
circulation, plant, boundary treatment, and associated  
works.

Cllrs resolved to **not object** to this application

**Planning Application No:** 8/24/0441/FUL  
**Location:** Terminal Building, Bournemouth Airport, Christchurch  
Dorset BH23 6DB  
**Proposal:** Extensions to passenger terminal buildings, provision of  
reconfigured transport interchange, landscaping and  
associated works (phased).

Cllrs. resolved to **comment** on this application. Cllrs are concerned about the treatment of effluent. They understand that the Airport is not connected to mains sewage. Clarification is required as to how the increase in the quantity of effluent will be treated. Any grant of permission should be conditional on no increase in nitrates, phosphates or other pollutants reaching the water courses. The Moors River which runs alongside the Airport site is an SSSI and its protection must be ensured.
