85/24 CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

87/24 SIGNING OF THE MINUTES

90/24 GENERAL PARISH MATTERS.

a) Open Spaces: Town Common/Sopley Common/Ramsdown, Hurn Forest:

b) Gravel Extraction

The Clerk had distributed the response from New Milton Sand and Ballast regarding restoration of the original Hurn Court Farm site. **Leave on Agenda for August meeting.**

c) Roads

Morebus will not revive the school bus service to Moors Close as it is not viable. The MOT for the motorhome parked in the layby outside Hurn Bridge Sports Club has expired. BCP Council have visited the occupant and provided advice. They will not take any action to remove the motorhome as he would potentially become homeless. The lack of an MOT is a police issue. They have been advised but have not

responded. Cllr I Evans will raise the issue at the next Single Point of contact meeting.

Cllr H Greenman raised concerns regarding a Landowner deposit LD7/1 registered with Dorset Council. He queried the registration of highways rights across the new section of Hurn Court Lane. Cllr Greenman agreed to contact Andy Brown, BCP Council to clarify the situation. When the Red Arrow crashed in the meadow alongside the river Stour the meadow was fenced off. This caused the footpath to be diverted to a narrow path alongside the river. Cllr H Greenman agreed to contact Philip Elias, BCP Council senior rights of way officer regarding the continued diversion. **Leave on Agenda for August meeting.**

c) Neighbourhood Plan

Cllr Mrs M Phipps updated Cllrs. There were 31 noise complaints for the year. 19 of these complaints were from repeat complainants.
